Land Purchase/Extension/Renovation

We are making a revised planning request to Woking BC of the proposed layout of the Clubhouse + extension. We have also applied for Planning Permission for construction of a scorebox & temporary umpires room where the BBQ is currently located and have been promised £250 from the Surrey Championship towards the costs.

We are now looking to start construction in January 2016 and be ready for the new season. The reason for the delay is that we need UK Power Networks to complete their work of laying the new cable through the car park.

The Club fund stands at £50,000 plus £35,000 from Ride London (not including profits from the Beer Festival) and the aim is to have approx. £100,000 by the end of the summer – this should be sufficient to commence construction in January. The Committee is determined to proceed despite set-backs in being awarded funding from various organisations. It is essential to the Club, members and local community that we have the facility to enable further expansion of the Club and to capitalise on our success.
