On behalf of the Club, the Committee would like to thank Greg Clough for his contribution and commitment as 2<sup>nd</sup> XI skipper over the last 6 years. He led the side through thick and thin and provided great encouragement and support to the Colts who graduated to senior league cricket.

A draft new management structure has been prepared to be discussed by the Committee and will be circulated for Members' comments during 2015. This will involve a new constitution for the Club which will need to be voted on at an EGM immediately before the 2015 AGM.

The 2015 AGM will be moved from the traditional last Thursday in November to the last Sunday in November, starting at 6.30pm, in an attempt to encourage more Members to attend.

# 2015 Colts Fees, Match Fees, Subscriptions

As agreed at the AGM all Colts training and match fees remain unchanged for 2015. The Colts Committee will be looking at the <u>option</u> of paying up front for a season's training fees with a discount in addition to pay-asyou-go. Further details will be available before the season starts.

All subscriptions (senior playing, Colts, non-playing etc.) remain unchanged from 2014.

Senior match fees will increase to £10/game or £17 for 2 games over a weekend. For Colts playing in senior sides the £5 match fee is unchanged. This is the first increase in match fees for 4 years and will offset additional costs including increase in League subscriptions as a result of the 1<sup>st</sup> XI achieving promotion to Div. 4, the 3<sup>rd</sup> XI joining the Fullers League, hire of Byfleet Rec for the 3<sup>rd</sup> XI and increased catering costs.

### **Halloween Party**

Attendance for the Halloween Party was disappointing with few Club playing members present. Lucy, Corinne and their merry band of helpers put in a lot of effort to prepare for the event and decorate the Clubhouse and it is a shame it was not as well supported as previously. The Fund Raising Committee will consider whether to repeat the event next year.

### Byfleet Rec Pitch Renovation & Fullers 3rd XI League

Woking BC have instructed Serco (the contractor) to prepare the Recreation Ground wicket for use next year and, as a result, we have applied and been accepted into the Fullers League 3<sup>rd</sup> XI League for 2015. This will open up more opportunities for the older Colts to play in senior cricket under adult League conditions. Iain Bowman and Rob Deven will manage and organise the side and necessary arrangements for playing at the Recreation ground. More details will follow towards the start of the season.

### Kings Head Lane/Byfleet Boys FC

We are still in discussions with Byfleet Village FC, Woking BC and the Football Foundation to create a square on the KHL ground in return for the football club being able to use our facilities for parking and for a 5/7-aside pitch on the ground. The delay is due to the Council waiting for a response from the Football Foundation for permission to create a square on the land as they funded the original conversion. If this is agreed, we would hope that a square could be ready for the 2016 season. A number of things need to be discussed and resolved e.g. wicket maintenance/preparation, access to facilities & the existing pavilion for preparation of teas, sightscreens etc. but this will mean the organisation and running of the 3<sup>rd</sup> XI will be considerably easier plus we will be able to use the wicket for Colts games.

We will look to the 3<sup>rd</sup> XI using the KHL ground from 2016 rather than the Recreation Ground.

### **Overseas Player for 2015**

No news as yet, Craig and Brian are working on finding a suitable player for us.

### Land Purchase/Extension/Renovation

The land purchase grinds on but there is light at the end of the tunnel. The Club will pay £4,500 up front and the remainder on a monthly basis, interest free over 2 years. We will draw up a Trust Deed to protect the land and appoint Trustees.

In addition we are working on updating the Trustees of the strip of land containing the oak trees opposite the Clubhouse. It is believed that the Club actually owns that land already but no documentation or Trust Deeds have been found as yet. Bob Goldsmith was the last surviving Trustee and he has resigned from that role and appointed the Trustees of the main ground to replace him.

### Car Park Extension

The work to bury the motorway overhead cables is due to start in Spring/Summer 2015 and be completed by end of 2015. It will still include extending the car park on both sides up to the entrance gate and a path round the back to the KHL ground at no cost to the Club.

### **Fund Raising**

We have mixed news on the fund raising front. The good news is that we have been granted £35,000 by The London Marathon Trust but Woking Council have deferred our application and it will be considered under the local plan – this could mean a delay whilst consultations take place. The Committee will meet shortly to discuss the options open to us.

In October we received a most generous donation of £2,500 from the Matthew Hackney Foundation towards the fund, including the latest grant, the fund stands at just over £79,000. We are in the process of making a grant application to BIFFA Trust under the Landfill Scheme for community projects and await a decision from Sport England on our £50,000 application, which is expected in April.

### Buy-a-Brick

For Club members, a "Red" brick costs £25 and a "Golden Brick" £50 and we are offering the opportunity to local businesses along with other sponsorship opportunities. Names will be permanently displayed within the new Clubhouse on a graphical "Wall of Bricks".

### **Captains & Honours Boards**

The new boards are currently being completed, updated and will be displayed in the Club. We have added an Honours Board and updated the President, Secretary and Treasurer's boards.

### Ground Equipment

We obtained a grant of £1,500 from Surrey County Council towards the purchase of a new ride-on mower for the ground which has now been acquired and delivered at a total cost of £1,900.
